Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled
 to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all
 students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes ontime graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

- 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: Mayfield College, 35-325 Date Palm Drive, Suite 101, Cathedral City, CA 92234 or 73680 Buena Vista Drive, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$100, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
- 6. Mayfield College reserves the right to perform an Administrative Cancellation of a student due to a violation of the College's Code of Conduct or to mitigating circumstances that may occur during a student's initial enrollment.
